

So what is the Freedom Project?

Supported through a partnership between Wales & West Utilities, Western Power Distribution and PassivSystems, the **Freedom Project** is an exciting project coming to the Bridgend area from May 2017; the project is looking at advanced ways to heat your home with a hybrid heating system.

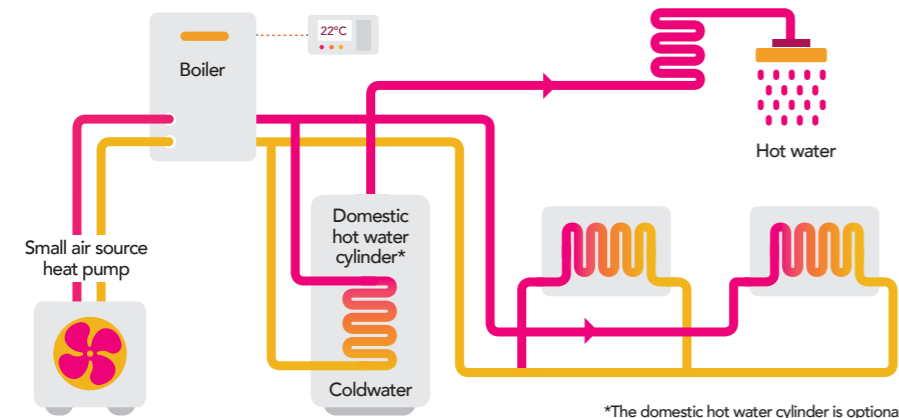
A hybrid heating system combines a gas boiler with an air source heat pump and will choose the cheapest way of heating your home.

A hybrid heating system automatically uses the most cost-effective heating mode at any time of day or night, all year-round. It takes into account external temperatures and internal heat and hot water

demand, as well as the relative cost of gas and electricity.

The **Freedom Project** team is looking for 75 homes in Bridgend to install hybrid heating systems.

It's a world-leading project, registered with and mainly funded by innovation allowances from Ofgem – the government regulator for gas and electricity in Great Britain.
